2. Sharing Practice – Equally Safe School	
Staff from Social Subjects department are leading on this project – to work with schools to stop gender based violence. ST gave a brief history of the project and the work done so far. A survey will be going out to pupils in the next few weeks, which will be anonymous and optional. Parents can also withdraw their child, information will be going out on the app regarding this. Staff are developing the curriculum to include areas which can also teach gender based violence issues alongside their subject.
