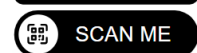

1. In S4 you will study English and Maths or Applications of Maths. In addition to these, five subjects should be selected. These should be numbered 1 to 5 in order of preference. A reserve subject should also be selected. This should be marked R. In S4 you should pick your best five subjects, this will ensure you have the best chance to maximise your attainment and select courses in S5 which will help with entry to University, college or training. Your Pupil Support Teacher will help you with this
2. Ayrshire College offers a range of courses at their Kilmarnock Campus, which our students can take advantage of, this will be instead of PSE and Core PE. Please see the Ayrshire College website showing the courses on offer and entry requirements. These courses will run on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons from 2 – 4pm. **A college application must be completed if you select this.**
3. Jam Steet Dance school is offering Dance at Level 4 or Level 5. This will take place on a Tuesday and Thursday afternoon. This will run on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons from 2 – 4pm. **You must have an audition to be accepted on this course.**
4. Pupils and parents/carers should use the Kilmarnock Academy Prospectus 2026 to help them decide which subjects should be chosen. A copy is available by scanning the QR Code (overleaf).
