What is Inclusive Digital Technologies?

Inclusive digital technologies is used as an umbrella term to describe all technologies and resources used to support children and young people with Additional Support Needs (ASN). Digital technologies allow all pupils to access the curriculum in a variety of ways, and supports inclusion and independence in learning.

Sensory Room

Our sensory room creates a welcoming and calm environment where all pupils can explore a range of technologies. The Magic Carpet allows pupils to explore numeracy, literacy and theme work through touch, sound and play.



Eye Gaze Technology

Eye gaze or eye tracking is a way of accessing your computer or communication aid using a mouse that you control with your eyes.

Eye gaze technology allows all pupils to fully participate in learning through digital technology, regardless of ability or potential barriers to learning they may face.
