Mrs McGonagle gave birth to a baby boy on Monday, no name as yet. All are well. Best wishes to the family.


Parent Council News

School Improvement Plan Updates

As you will be aware we have a School Improvement Plan (full plan is on school website). The Parent Council are updated at each meeting on progress and the plan and minutes from this are available on the website but we thought it may be an idea to share in newsletters a short update on one of the areas. Our areas this session are: Attainment - Play, Literacy; Assessment - profiling as part of children's work, Staged Intervention paperwork; HWB - resilience/PATHs, Rights Respecting School, leadership - children; Cluster work - SEALs training in numeracy, Growth mindset in numeracy.

In attainment we have been working closely with the Fundraising Group to improve our school library. We have bought books for all levels of reading ability and the parents have worked really hard to get the library refreshed and ready for the children. We are now about to start lending books out from this. We have also been looking at books for the children to use in classes, again funded by the Fundraising Group. All teaching staff have had reading development training and we have had some of the support staff being trained by the authority.

In play we are building on the very good work that was done in P1 last session alongside our Quality Improvement Officer - Anne Dalziel, Educational Psychology, Strathclyde University and Education Scotland. We are adapting this to develop the P2 curriculum. Although we are implementing play, this is very carefully planned by the teachers to ensure that the children are using play to apply their skills in the curriculum. All staff working in the lower stages have attended training run by East Dunbartonshire Council and are working with partners to share good practice and moderate standards of attainment in professional learning groups across the authority.
