






### Signs of God: Confession & Anointing of the Sick

I have developed my understanding of why we need reconciliation in our relationship with God and with others and can explain the effects of the Fall of Adam and Eve (Original Sin)	$\odot \odot \odot$
I have matured in my <b>understanding of sin</b> and can explain the meaning of <b>mortal and venial sin.</b>	
I can explain that <b>God is loving and forgiving</b> and this is why <b>He reaches out to us in the sacraments.</b>	
I have learned about and experienced how to use an <b>examination of conscience</b> .	
I can explain the three elements of the sacrament of reconciliation: Contrition, Confession and Satisfaction (Penance)	
I understand that all sin damages my relationship with God but that mortal sin isolates us from His grace.	
I understand that <b>confession</b> is the sacrament in which I can <b>recover the state of grace</b> (friendship with God) if I have the misfortune to fall into <b>mortal sin</b> .	$\odot \odot \odot$
I know that I must be in a <b>state of grace</b> to receive <b>Holy Communion</b> . This means that if I have fallen into mortal sin, I must <b>go to confession before I am able to receive</b> . I should still go to Sunday Mass even if I am not able to receive.	◎
I can explain the key elements of the <b>Sacrament of the Sick</b> and recognise that this sacrament may bring <b>physical healing</b> but also bring <b>spiritual strength</b> to <b>trust God more through suffering.</b>	© © ®




