Programme Introduction:

As the young people of Primary 7 develop both physically and intellectually, they will experience an increasing demand to both understand and develop leadership skills inside school and outside in their community. Many of them already have responsibilities and commitments that allow them to develop these skills and knowledge. It is a priority at Busby Primary that the P7's are engaged in leadership activities throughout their final year at primary school so that they will be well-equipped to cope with the challenges of secondary education, further education and the world of work.

There is a growing political and educational agenda to provide young people with the right skills and knowledge to help them both understand and be prepared for the world of work. At Busby Primary school, we believe that our input and programmes make a positive contribution towards that worthwhile requirement and stress to the pupils how important it is to use their significant talents to the fullest.

As a result of the above and a growing desire within the entire Busby Community for our children to be the best they can be, we are embarking on a pupil leadership training programme led by the Head Teacher, a consultant from business and the classroom teachers.



This programme will first and foremost seek to develop skills and knowledge within our young people but it will also set a context for the P7s about what happens within the various sectors within the world of work.

Our management consultant, John Curran has worked in and with a significant number of major companies in three continents and will share some of his experiences and insights with the P7s during our programme. He currently conducts leadership training for people in a variety of sectors and coaches senior executives on how to improve their leadership skills.
