


Meeting of: Pupil Council P4 – P7

Minutes of the meeting held on 28th October

- a) They were agreed as an accurate record
- b) No matters arising from last meeting's minutes

1 Problems with football at lunchtime: There are difficulties in the playground with boys and girls playing football, particularly Primary 5. There is a rota but where they have a day each, but people don't always adhere to it. Beth and Melody are going to make a rota and share with all classes. They will ask teachers to remind pupils whose turn it was each day. The rota will be for ball games and not restricted to football.

2 Opportunities for Prefect duties for P5: there was a discussion that P5 might have a chance after Easter when P6s start perfecting. Mrs Loudon will find out if there are any opportunities for P5 to 'prefect' in the nursery or P1.

3 Christmas Jumper day: there was a suggestion that we hold a 'Christmas Jumper' day to raise funds for Save the Children. It was agreed this would be a good idea and will take place on Friday 12th December.

4 Boys toilet doors: the P5-7 boys toilet doors don't work very well. It was reported that two boys got locked in yesterday and some of the doors don't lock. Mrs Loudon will speak to Mr Goodwin and ask him to look into it.

5 Anti Bullying: Last week was anti-bullying week and all classes looked at different aspects of bullying and how to deal with it. It was felt that it would be helpful to gather the views of pupils about bullying, eg do pupils know what to do, who to report it to and do they think it gets dealt with effectively.

6 Holes in the playground: there is a hole in the ground under the gazebo and one on the path. It gets very muddy and some children kicked the water around. Mrs Loudon has spoken to someone about this and it is going to get sorted soon.

Any other business: Complaints

Some children have been pushing and shoving on the path in the way out of school. Councillors should remind everyone about walking out of school sensibly.

Some children have been riding their bikes and scooters in the playground. Councillors should remind everyone about safety and they should not ride bikes or scooters in the playground. The new bike shelter is completed and pupils should be encouraged to use it to store their bikes during the day.

Cloakrooms have been very untidy recently and it was reported this was a hazard at P6 and P7 for the nursery pupils. It was thought it may be a good idea to have cloakroom of the week, announced at assembly on a Friday. Mrs Loudon will talk to pupils about this.
