World Book Day- 1st March 2018



Within Crookfur Primary School and Nursery Class, we have planned a range of activities to celebrate World Book Day. Please see below for an overview of some of the activities we have planned in school, our Nursery Class will send out separate information in due course ☺.

Who?	What?
P1-7	Enjoy reading in the <i>Book Nook</i> - a special place to enjoy sharing a story with friends
P1-7	Authors and Illustrators Live Events- Biggest Book Show- shows to inspire children to pick up a book and get reading!
P1-7	Design a Book Token competition- a national competition with lots of prizes. One lucky winner's design will be turned into a real National Book Token gift card and distributed to hundreds of bookshops nationwide in time for Christmas
P3-7	Reading experiences supported by Virtual Reality. P7 students will assist in bringing a text to life using virtual and augmented reality. This will then be used as a context for weekly story writing.
P4-7	First Minister's Reading Challenge- Reading Passports House Points Awards. During Book Week Scotland the children were set a reading challenge. House Points will be awarded to children who have been making lots of entries in the Reading Passports.
P4-6	Learn to be a Story Teller. Children will learn how to tell a story using a story path rather than reading from a book.
P1-6	Story telling experience. Children will pair up to try out their story telling skills with younger children. (P6 & P3, P5 & P2, P4 & P1)

P1-P7	Shoebox Story Diorama (More information to follow)

In addition to the activities listed above, there will be other experiences planned within individual classes and of course at the local libraries. All children will also receive a World Book Day £1 Book Token. There are lots of great books specially priced at £1 to celebrate the day.
