Last Year

Last year we raised an amazing £5849 and so want to give you all a big thank you!

- Our Halloween discos were amazing fun and a great success and raised a total of £809.
- We ran a Christmas card design service this year and made a profit of £406.
- The Christmas Fair was the highlight of our fundraising in the first half of the year and made the magnificent sum of £2100.
- In March we had a family movie night and watched Trolls together, raising £216.
- At both sports days a refreshments stall was run which raised £227.
- Finally we rounded off the year with our amazing fun day and raffle. These were both very popular and together raised a brilliant £2091.

We have some expenditure requests from the school already, plus our big-ticket item of the Activity Trail which is bubbling out of view as we try to secure external funding. The Activity Trail will cost in the region of £15000 and will be positioned on the grass to the side of the little path leading round the back of the gazebo (and therefore accessible to all children). We are opening a new fund account for this and are putting in a donation of £2000 from our balance to get it started; we expect to see this balance growing soon. We know how much everyone wants one back and are doing our very best to move it forward!

The three current requests are an update to the Outdoor Classroom at P6/7 to turn it into Crookfur Quiet Zone, an extension to the school's Opus PA system (we all know they need more microphones!), and worry letterboxes to allow the children to 'post' any concerns to staff. You'll see from the list from last year though that there will most definitely be more items required as the year progresses!
