Please find below our learning from August to December 2017:

Science... We will be learning about electricity and will be exploring our school to identify how electricity is used within our learning environment. We will also be learning about the properties of water through our topic 'Freezing and Melting'. We are looking forward to our visits in the autumn and winter months to Linn Park.

Social Studies... The focus for this planning block is 'Our School and our Local Community'. There are lots of people in our school who work with and help the children and it will be exciting to learn about the different roles they play in our school life.
