<p><b>Beginners</b> - New to the sport or one or two hours experience</p> <p><b>Improvers</b> – Can control speed using a snowplough from halfway on the small slope.</p> <p><b>Intermediate</b> - Can link snowplough turns to control speed from top of small slope.</p> <p><b>Advanced / Intermediate</b> - Can ski with confidence on the main slope, allowing skis to become parallel between turns.</p> <p><b>Advanced</b> - Able to link parallel turns on the main slope</p>
