

Dear Parents

As part of our Promoting Positive Behaviour Policy update, we have been asking the pupils their views on how they would like to see positive behaviour being promoted in our school. They have decided that pupils who consistently follow the school rules and show kindness and respect for others, should be rewarded. They have devised a programme of events to take place each month e.g. extra playtime, school cinema, outdoor activities, cooking, ICT time, free time.

To be eligible take part in these events, the pupils have decided that positive behaviour should be demonstrated and a requisite number of merits must be gained to take part in the activities. All pupils have been issued with a "Gotcha" card today to record the number of merits they gain. For the first event, pupils have decided that they must achieve 15 out of the 20 merits.
