



Uplawmoor Primary School Pupil Council Constitution

The United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child states in Article 12 that "children have the right to express the views they have and those views should be listened to in anything that affects them".

The Pupil Council will;

- Allow all children at Uplawmoor Primary School to have a voice
- Help make the school and local community a better place.
- Help improve learning in the school.
- To raise funds for the school.

For decisions to be made at a meeting, there must be at least 4 members present (one from each class wherever possible) and decisions are made through a "show of hands" vote in which the majority rules.

The Pupil Council Rules are as follows:

All Pupil Council members must:

- be respectful and listen to others.
- contribute or take part in meetings.
- follow the school rules and be role models to other pupils.
- model good behaviour at all times.
- be polite and courteous to others.
- not refer to specific individuals or groups during discussions.
- use their position on Pupil Council to support and develop their school.

We understand the Pupils Councils role in the school and agree to follow the rules of the Pupil Council.
