

Universal Credit (where your monthly earned income is not more than £610); Income Support; Income-based Employment and Support Allowance; Income-based Job Seeker's Allowance; Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999; Child Tax Credit but not Working Tax Credit; your income is less than £16,105 a year; and both maximum Child Tax Credit and maximum Working Tax Credit and your income is less than £6,420.
