What is Transition?

Transition is the term we use in school when children change stages. In primary school there are TWO key transition points. At the beginning when children start in Primary 1 and at the end in Primary 7 as they get ready to begin High School. Normally, across our individual schools, we would have a robust transitions program that runs through the months of May and June to support and encourage our children and families at this key time of change.

This year what we are able to do and offer is very different as a result of the circumstances that we find ourselves in globally.

Our transition programme therefore is very different to reflect the need to follow local and government guidance on minimizing the risk of infection.

Transition to Primary 1

All of the children from linking nursery classes will have transition sessions during the month of June. This is for ALL pre-school children who will be attending either Carlibar Primary School or another school in the Barrhead/Neilston area as detailed below.

Children who attend Carlibar Nursery Class but are enrolled in a school not in a Barrhead/Neilston school should receive communication from the Head Teacher of their primary school directly from them about visits.

There will also be **two** opportunities to visit your child's Primary School detailed as follows.

The focus will be on getting ready for school and what they are excited about or have a worry about.

In Carlibar Primary School :

Your child will get to meet their new teacher and visit their classroom, meeting some of their new classmates. The children will have an opportunity to meet some of the new faces (staff in the school and have a tour of all the important bits of the school). This will be able to be reinforced at home through our virtual tour that you will be able to share with your child at home (as many times as you like).

We will also provide a handbook for parents which we hope will cover Frequently Asked Questions.

Social distancing measures will be in place during your child's attendance at I kindly request that you follow these in order to keep everyone safe. Unfortunately at the moment parents are not permitted inside the school.

You will receive a letter detailing the class your child is in, and who their teacher will be once we have this clarified **before** the transition visit.
