Support for Learning

What support is on offer in S3 and S4 for pupils with Additional Support Needs?

In middle school support varies depending on the pupil needs. Support on offer from Support for Learning complements the support offered by departments.

Support with assessment

Readers/Scribes/Extra time/ICT

By this stage we would expect pupils to talk to class teachers and SFL to agree on supports for any assessments they are going to sit. It is essential pupils take support for internal assessments if they want to access support in the SQA exams. The school needs this evidence for the SQA in order to put in place the same supports in the formal exam diet.

Target Setting

Pupils that are finding it difficult to find the motivation to 'get started' can come along to Support for Learning where they will be given 'study homework' to help them get started and prioritise what they need to learn.

Drop-in

Support for Learning has an open door policy from 8.30 till the end of school each day. All pupils are welcome to come along if they have concerns about their progress.

Exam Study Support

During exam leave pupils can come to Support for Learning each day when they have exam leave. They will be able to study and receive support with any concerning they have with work...this can save a lot of stress at home, as the day's study is completed at school.

In Class Support

When needed pupils maybe in a class with 2 staff, one subject teacher and one SFL teacher or support assistant. This is to ensure that pupils have the support to allow them to achieve in class and work to their full potential.

Base Support

Some pupils may not follow the full timetable their friends do and may come to SFL to work in small group tutorials to assist with core skills/social and communication skills and support with class work.
