Support for Learning

In senior school there is support on offer from Support for Learning in addition to the support offered by departments.

Study periods in Support for Learning

Pupils are welcome to come to Support for Learning when they are not in class. There is an area designated for seniors, where they can study quietly and make a cup of tea! Staff are on hand to help out with any issues.

Support with assessment

Readers/Scribes/Extra time. By this stage we would expect pupils to come to SFL or their class to arrange the supports for any assessments they are going to take. It is essential pupils take support for internal assessments if they want to have support in the SQA exams. The school needs this evidence for the SQA in order to put in place the same supports in the exam diet in May.

Study Club

Support for Learning run a study club for senior pupils after school. Here pupils will get help to organise their studying, and how to make the most of the time they spend studying taking into account their style of learning. Pupils need to come to SFL to book in.

Target Setting

Pupils that are finding it difficult to find the motivation to 'get started' can come along to Support for Learning where they will be given 'study homework' to help get started and prioritise what they need to learn.

Drop—in

Support for Learning has an open door policy from 8.30 till the end of school each day. All pupils are welcome to come along if they have concerns about their progress.

Exam Study Support

During exam leave pupils can come to Support for Learning each day when they have exam leave. They will be able to study and receive support with any concerning they have with work...this can save a lot of stress at home, as the day's study is completed at school.
