# Musical Theatre Course

This course is designed to develop, to the highest standards, the pupils' individual skills and potential in dance, drama and singing, providing the training needed for the true "triple threat" performer.

- Up to 6 hours specialist training daily
- Full academic curriculum in Knightswood Secondary
- Residential accommodation (provided if necessary)
- Entry S3 (Preparatory Course) and S5
- Dance classes include ballet, commercial jazz, contemporary movement, tap and body conditioning
- Voice production and dialect, improvisation, textual studies, character awareness and monologue
- One to one singing lessons, ensemble work, choral classes and performance classes
- ISTD dance examinations
- ATCL Diploma in Musical Theatre
- Annual showcase and full musical production for S5 and S6 in June
- Regular workshops from visiting artists and companies
- Full physiotherapy and gyrotonic support
- No tuition fees
