


Using Glow tools at home

What is Glow? Watch this overview video

1. Navigate to https://sts.platform.rmunify.com/account/signin/glow on any internet-enabled device.



- 2. At Barrhead High School we use a variety of digital applications via GLOW to support learning and teaching within the classroom and at home. Your child uses their Glow login details to access these supports. Their username should be entered in the top box (for example **gw14smithjohn**) and their password in the bottom box.
- 3. If your child has forgotten their password then they should contact their pastoral teacher to get this rectified or email gw11herddavid@glow.sch.uk for support.
- 4. When logged in, your child has access to the same apps and platforms that they are already familiar with in school. These look the same as they do in school. These include Google Classroom, Google Drive, OneDrive and Microsoft 365 tools.



Google Classroom is used in Barrhead High as a digital classroom, where teachers and students can communicate with each other and where assignments and other learning activities can be posted. Google Drive and OneDrive are online storage apps for files, photos and other learning resources. Files can also be shared between teachers and students in these areas.

It is important to remember that comments in these virtual learning environments should only be between students and teachers. Parents should contact schools through the usual channels (phone or email).



Download Microsoft Office365

Office 365 Pro Plus allows all Glow users to download the latest version of the Microsoft Office Suite on to a total of 15 home machines and personal devices, free of charge. This includes Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Access, OneNote and Sway.
