Announcements

- **Masks reminder!** 'Mask up and move'. We should all be wearing face coverings when we are moving about the school in corridors, queuing at the canteen and when visiting the toilets. Reminder that:
 - ⇒ Mask/Face coverings should not be shared with others.
 - ⇒ When storing a mask/ face covering, it should be placed in a sealed bag or container.
 - ⇒ Avoid placing it on surfaces, to reduce the risk of infection.
 - ⇒ Re-usable mask/ face coverings should be washed after each day of use in school at 60 degrees centigrade or in boiling soapy water.
- **S3 Duke of Edinburgh Group** There will be a virtual Parents & Carers Information Evening for all S3 Duke of Edinburgh students on Monday, 5th October at 7pm. On the evening the Bronze DOFE award will be explained including all costs that are involved. All S3 students thinking about completing the DOFE Bronze award this year should join this online meeting with a parent or carer. 

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
