### What is the Engineering Academy?

The Engineering Academy offers you an alternative route into an Engineering degree at the University of Strathclyde. The first year is an enhanced HNC programme which is taught at one of seven partner colleges and allows direct transfer into a variety of degree programmes in the following departments here at the University of Strathclyde:

- Biomedical Engineering\*
- Chemical & Process Engineering
- Civil & Environmental Engineering
- Design, Manufacture & Engineering Management
- Electronic & Electrical Engineering
- Mechanical & Aerospace Engineering
- Naval Architecture, Ocean & Marine Engineering

# **Entry Requirements:**

We typically ask for four Highers at BBBB which must include Maths and Physics. For entry to Chemical Engineering, Higher Chemistry is also required and for entry to Biomedical Engineering, Higher Biology or Human Biology is also required.

We want to increase opportunities for people from every background and we select based on merit, potential and ability to succeed. Certain applicants may be eligible for a lower offer and our minimum entry requirements are BBCC.
