Supporting families: Parent Employability Support Fund

Working parents on a low-income in East Renfrewshire are being encouraged to take advantage of a new programme designed to help them increase household income. The Parental Employment Support Fund (PESF), which is funded by the Scottish Government, helps parents identify and work towards a new employment goal, learn new skills, search for jobs and prepare for interviews and link with employers looking for staff with their skills and experience – all with the ultimate goal of helping residents to earn more

money. Lone parents, families where the parent or child has a disability, parents with three or more children, from an ethnic minority, whose youngest child is under 1 years old and parents aged under 25 years old, who have the right to work in the UK, are all eligible.
