## Remote learning

## Schools Asymptomatic Testing Programme

We have received information regarding testing for staff and S4/5/6 learners. Along with the other protective measures we are implementing to keep our school community safe, regular testing of staff and senior phase pupils will help to further reduce risks for staff and young people in our

school. We are currently processing all the information and will be in touch with senior phase learners and parents to provide further information and to seek consent for your child to participate.

### **Contingency planning**

We continue to plan for any phased return to school after the 22<sup>nd</sup> February. All plans will be subject to any further announcements made on the 16<sup>th</sup> February. At the moment we are planning for all contingencies:

- Phase 1: Identify learners in S4/5/6 practical subjects and create a bespoke timetable for learners to attend. Planning will be based on a maximum of 8% of learners attending at any one time. Technical guidance is due to be published on 12<sup>th</sup> February to support our planning.
- Phase 2: Confirm a delivery model for S4/5/6 learners to return part time (blended learning) whilst S1/2/3 remain at home (remote learning)
- Phase 3: Review our blended learning plans for all year groups to return part-time (timetables were issued previously)
- Phase 4: all learners return full time

### **SQA**

Following on from consultation with the Parent Council, we have issued potential assessment calendars to S4/5/6 learners and parents. We may need to continue to change dates, however this will give learners a plan and an understanding of assessment windows.
