Free Period Products

As part of East Renfrewshire Council's support for communities and a commitment to equality, ERC offer free period products in a range of venues for people to take however much they need, whenever they need it, for whoever needs it.

These products are available at various venues across the whole of East Renfrewshire, including all schools. We will continue to make products available in as many places as possible, and specifically through NHS health centres, leisure facilities, community centres, libraries and community organisations.

The PickupMyPeriod app directs users to the nearest location where free period products are available based upon either the user's GPS location or an entered postcode. It allows users to filter what products are available, in which locations and building opening hours.

Our office is also part of this scheme and welcomes those in need to drop in during office hours: Monday to Friday 9.30 - 15.00.

NHSGGC - Virtual A&E

NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde have a virtual A&E service, named the Flow Navigation Centre (FNC), which provides patients with direct access to emergency care from the comfort of their own homes.

The service operates 10am until 10pm seven days a week and can be accessed by calling NHS24 on 111 and should be used for urgent, but non-life-threatening health concerns.

Pension Credit Awareness Day

Pension Credit Awareness Day marks the end of a twoweek push to encourage as many older people to take up this benefit as possible.

Pension Credit, is a vital financial boost that can be worth over £3,300 a year. It also entitles those aged 75 and above to a free TV Licence. It tops up weekly income to a guaranteed minimum level of £182.60 a week for single pensioners or £278.70 for couples.

The Department for Work and Pensions recently revealed that although 1.4 million older people in Britain receive Pension Credit, many are still not claiming this extra financial help — with an estimated £1.7bn currently left unclaimed.

For the last two weeks the BBC has helped to raise awareness of the DWP's campaign by running radio trails on all BBC local radio stations (plus Radio Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland), to encourage listeners to find out if they are eligible. The DWP have a Pension Credit Calculator.
