Good News Story -

A client came into ERCAB Office as he had received a bill from British Gas for a total of £3460.60 and was being threatened with a warrant to enter his property.

The client is a customer of Scottish Power and has been paying his monthly direct debit to them. Understandably, the client was extremely worried about this situation as he knew he had been paying his bill and was able to provide statements from Scottish Power to the effect.

ERCAB contacted 2nd utility company, who advised the client had 2 gas metres registered to his property; one of which was theirs and that is why he has been billed for this. After explaining that the client was in fact a customer of Scottish Power, they advised this would have to be checked at the property by providing the meter serial numbers.

An adviser attended the clients' property and took gas meter readings for the 2nd utility company; after doing this they were able to see that the client was not liable for the substantial bill and agreed to send out an engineer to locate the gas meter and which property this related to.

The client was delighted that ERCAB was able to sort this out for this and he has since received a letter from British Gas stating he is **not** liable for the £3460.60.

Case Study -

A grandmother contacted the bureau for advice on attaining her grandson citizenship, as he is South-African and moved here to live with his father and grandparents. The father is British, but born outside of the UK and the child has no contact with the mother, who is still in South Africa.

We helped to advise the client on how Register the grandson as British by discretion, as normally both parental consent is required.

The child was granted his Citizenship and the family no longer need to be concerned about his residency in the UK.
