Good News Story - Benefits

A client approached ERCAB for the first time in November 2021 for assistance to register an appeal following the loss of her PIP award. She had completed the review form and mandatory reconsideration herself due to difficulty accessing support during Lockdown. The appeal was lodged by the Bureau representative then a new client meeting undertaken to collect information, develop a client/advisor relationship and instruct the collation of appropriate supporting evidence for the appeal submission. During this period the client disclosed that her husband had lost his PIP award during Lockdown in 2020, having completed his PIP review form himself and not known how to challenge the decision.

The client's video appeal was successful with an award of Standard Rate Daily Living and Mobility components, generating a client financial gain of £86.30 a week (£4,487 p.a) with a backdated lump sum of £4k to the end of the previous award.

Subsequently the Adviser completed a new PIP application for the client's husband who had an industrial injuries award in place since 1979 as well as additional health conditions affecting all aspects of daily living . This resulted in an automatic award of Enhanced Rate Daily Living and Standard Rate Mobility and a client financial gain of £116.85 a week (£6076.20 p.a).

The couple were delighted and now have the financial capability to access the support required due to their individual health care issues.

Free School Meals/Clothing Grants -

East Renfrewshire Council have now opened applications for Clothing Grants and Free School Meals 2022/23.

This year the amount of clothing grant you can get is £120 per primary school child and £150 per secondary school child.

You can apply online for a clothing grant and free school meals by logging in or signing up for a MyEastRen account www.eastrenfrewshire.gov.uk/login. If you don't have a MyEastRen account you can apply via ERC Benefits Online.

You will have to provide proof of elgibility for these; a full list of acceptable evidence, along with full information on this scheme can be found by visiting the below website: eastrenfrewshire.gov.uk/free-school-meals#Qualifying

If you get free school meals or a clothing grant, you may also be eligible for extra funded childcare for any pre school children. 2 year olds in families who qualify can get 1140 hours of free early learning and childcare.
