Free Period Products -

As part of East Renfrewshire Council's support for communities and commitment to equality, they offer free period products in a range of venues for people to take however much they need, whenever they need it, for whoever needs it.

At present, the following products are available:

- Individually wrapped day pads and tampons
- Packets of day and night towels
- Boxes of regular and super tampons
- Menstrual cups
- Reusable cloth pads

These products are available at various venues across the whole of East Renfrewshire, including all schools and our Citizens Advice Bureau.

The PickupMyPeriod app directs users to the nearest location where free period products are available based upon either the user's GPS location or an entered postcode.

Cost of Living Payments -

UK Government has updated their website with details on Cost of Living payments for the new financial year.

For those in receipt of low income benefits, there will be 3 payments making up payments of £900 over the next year:

- £301 paid between 25 April 2023 and 17 May 2023 for most people on DWP income benefits
- £300 paid during autumn 2023 for most people.
- £299 paid during spring 2024 for most people.

You do not need to apply. If you're eligible, you'll be paid automatically in the same way you usually get your benefit or tax credits. This includes if you're found to be eligible at a later date.

These payments are not taxable and will not affect the benefits or tax credits you get.
