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## UNDERSTAND

Take the time to think about what you're trying to grasp. How does it relate to you? Are you listening in class? If you don't get it yet, then ask for help.

## CONDENSE

It's not possible to remember everything. Make it smaller and more manageable with **coloured** notes, mind maps or post it notes to organise key points.

## **MEMORISE**

Rather than just rereading your notes, make things more memorable by using your imagination with funny stories, rhymes or songs that help you relate to the topic.

## REVIEW

Break the forgetting curve! Make time to come back and review after a day, then a week and a month to help it stick in your long term memory. Test yourself or ask someone to test you, don't let all your hard work drain away.

#### What are cells?

Cells are the building blocks of all living organisms. Organisms made of a single cell, such as bacteria and the fungus yeast, are described as being <u>unicellular</u>.

Organisms made of many cells such as animals, most plants and many species of fungi, are described as being <u>multicellular</u>.

Multicellular organisms can be made up of millions of cells.




Microscope view of plant cells

Cells are microscopic, so to see their structure we need to use microscopes. We can see more structures clearly if we use stains to colour specimens before putting them under the microscope.

Stains are coloured dyes that are absorbed by some cell structures but not by others. An example of a stain which is used is iodine.


