### **Assessment Arrangements (AA)**

Assessment is part of learning.

Teachers, equipped with detailed knowledge of your child's individual needs, ensure the right support is in place so that your child can demonstrate their learning.

#### Examples of supports:

Digital Question Papers (DQPs)	Additional time (for learners with processing or physical difficulties)		
Ivona (text-to-speech "read aloud" software)	Practical assistance (for learners with physical/ motor impairments)		
ICT	Bilingual dictionary		
Spell-check (for learners with identified spelling difficulty)	Human scribe (for learners with substantial difficulties who cannot use ICT)		

#### **Assessment Arrangements (AA)**

For SQA examinations in S4, S5 and S6, the school must submit evidence of the support that pupils use and require to access assessments.

- AA are determined by individual needs
- AA are evidence-based and mirror ongoing support in class
- AA often vary across subjects
- AA do not compensate for a lack of attainment
- AA cannot compromise the integrity of the assessment
