




Taylor Swift

AT HOME FUN

Halloween Cookies

Ingredients

- 150g softened butter
- 50g caster sugar
- 100g light brown sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1 large egg
- 250g plain flour
- ¼ tsp baking powder
- · 100g milk chocolate chips
- · 60g melted dark chocolate
- 60g icing sugar, mixed with 2 tsp of water
- Maltesers
- Oreos

Instructions

- 1. Preheat the oven to 180C/160C fan/gas 4, and line two baking sheets with parchment paper.
- 2. Beat the butter and sugars together until light and fluffy, then add in the vanilla and egg. Mix to combine.
- 3. With a wooden spoon, stir in the flour and baking powder, then fold in the chocolate chip cookies.
- 4. Divide the dough into 20 balls, and spread out on the two baking sheets. Press the tops gently with your hand.
- 5. Bake for 10-12 minutes, then remove from the oven and let them cool for 10 minutes.
- 6. Spider design: Using the melted chocolate, stick two maltesers to the cookie to make the body. Then use chocolate and icing to pipe on the legs, eyes and any details you want.
- 7. Bat design: Separate the oreos, and scrape off the filling. Cut the oreo biscuits in half and use icing to stick them to the cookies as wings. Then use chocolate to stick a malteser to the cookie to make a body. Then use chocolate and icing to pipe on the eyes and any details you want.

Notes

 You can use two ziplock bags with the corners cut off as piping bags for the icing and chocolate.


Q) What's your all-time favourite movie?

A) "I'd work in renewable energy, you know, solar or wind power."








