# **Nursery Hours/Security**

Nursery Sessions are from **8.50/9am to 12.noon** and from **12.50/1pm-4.00pm**.

Staff will supervise the door from 8.50am until 9.00am and again from 12.50pm until 1.00pm. After 9am and 12.40pm the Nursery door will be closed. Any parents arriving after these times will have to register in the main school office and then take their child through the school to Nursery where your child should be signed in as usual. The door will open at 11.50am during the morning session and at 3.50pm during the afternoon session to allow children to be signed out, shoes changed etc by the end of the session. If for any reason you have to collect your child early from Nursery or you are arriving after the Nursery doors have closed, please do so through the main school building and sign your child in or out at the office.
