Welcome and Introductions

COP26 Assembly

The children had all watched the assembly video in their classes and had had purposeful discussions around the SDGs.

• Climate Change Learning in Class

Classes shared some of their current climate change learning.

- P5 have been working on a Global Storylines project.
- P4 have been learning about overfishing.
- P6 have been learning about clean energy.
- Eco Green Flag update

Miss Paisey explained that the Green Flag was due for renewal in January 2022 and that our three focus areas are still Litter, Global Citizenship and School Grounds.

Global Citizenship is being covered by individual class learning and the 'Junior Global Citizens' committee.

Miss Paisey is going to lead the Litter section and our first targets will be to write a Litter Policy and consider ways to reduce the playground litter. Maya suggested bringing back a playground competition which was a popular idea.
