Charities

- there could be a charity day on which groups sell things they have made pupils could bring £2 each and spend it on whichever items they wanted
- each House could support a charity and there could be a reward for the House which raises most

- groups should fundraise in their own time, outwith school
- there should be two 'Dress As You Please' days throughout the year and pupils should pay £1 to wear their own clothes or four days at 50p each
- donation amounts/prices should be reduced so that parents have to spend less
- a vote on which charities to support should be held at assembly
- there should be a school charity shop/stall at which different groups can sell items –
 this could be expanded to an online shop
- there should be a Charity Fayre once a year
- pupils could donate their tuck money on designated days
