
An Example of a properly completed design brief;

"I am going to design a headpiece for a special occasion like a red carpet event. The target market is young female, aged between 20 – 30 with an edgy style. It should be influenced by the floral theme but with a modern twist. The colours should be bright and warm and must be restricted to three colours. The design should fit comfortably on the head and be easy to take on and off. It must stand out in photographs and be clearly visible from a distance whilst containing detail and pattern which can be viewed close up.


