Dear Parent/ Carer,

As part of our Safer Routes to School and Eco Agenda, we will be running a Walking Bus **next week beginning 18th of November**. Since it is powered only by good old fashioned leg work, our Walking Bus promotes healthy exercise, reduces dangerous traffic around our school gates and reduces traffic pollution, thereby improving the health and safety of all our pupils.

We would love as many pupils from Primary 1-7 to take part on our short walk. On Monday the **18th of November** we will be meeting at the Co-Operatives on Harvie Avenue. Also, on Wednesday the **20th of November** we will complete another walk from Patterton Train Station.

Please do not send pupils with bicycles or scooters as this can cause complications and can slow down the Walking Bus.

As our Walking Bus is informal, we must stress that it is the responsibility of parents to decide if their child should join the walking bus. The safety of any pupil whilst walking with the bus remains the responsibility of their parents or carers until they arrive on the school premises.

We will meet at the front of Co-Op at 8.30am on Monday 18th and at Patterton Train Station 8.30am on Wednesday 20th. Please arrive promptly as we will be leaving sharply. Pupils can join the walking bus at any point along the route.
