## **Winter Weather Contingencies**

This week as we have had a bit of a change in the weather, I thought it wise to draw your attention to the contingency arrangements we have in place to deal with occasions when emergencies make it necessary for children to be sent home early. Although it is very rare for a school to close, we have experienced it in previous years. The decision to close a school rests with the Director of Education and parents/carers will be notified as early as possible using the following methods of communication: Email, Text Messaging, School Website and Twitter feed. During the winter months, children should wear suitable clothing to school in case of inclement weather. A waterproof jacket with hood and school shoes/boots should be worn when pupils are outside. Our playground staff find lots of children are reluctant to put their hoods up, however we try our best to encourage them to do so. If it is very wet or icy, the children remain in their classrooms at intervals and are supervised by prefects and staff.

Thank you to everyone for their patience and support on Thursday and Friday this week as we helped all of the children into school safely. P1 and P2 children in particular coped well leaving their parents at the gate. I think it may have helped that they could join the train and special thanks to our P7 helpers for keeping the children company and seeing them to class.

## **Family Centre Update**
