Dear Parents and Carers

I hope that you were able to enjoy the holiday weekend – I am sure that the snow helped provide some much needed entertainment for the children.

## **Covid-19 Update**

We are continuing to plan for the phased re-opening of the school and family centre from 22<sup>nd</sup> February. More detailed information will follow for the parents/carers of children in the family centre and P1-3, however some general information is noted below:

- ✓ All children should attend the family centre for their full entitlement and on the days allocated. There will be no further provision for the children of key workers at the family centre.
- ✓ Children in P1-P3 will attend school. This will include the P3 children in our P3/4 composite class, but not the P4 children in this class who will continue remote learning.
- ✓ In-school provision will still be available for children of keyworkers and other identified children across P4-7.
- ✓ Staggered school day timings will continue as follows:

P2 children and keyworker provision 8.55am – 3.00pm

P1 and P3 children- 9.05am-3.15pm

## **School Provision**

With the planned phased return to school, I understand that some parents/carers who have been working from home or on a rota e.g. school staff, may now require access to provision in school.

The requirements for essential childcare continue to be that both parents/carers must be keyworkers who are unable to work from home and have no alternative child care provision.

## **Standardised Testing**

East Renfrewshire's programme of standardised testing for reading and maths is usually carried out in February. Tests are given to children in P3, P5 and P7 and provide teachers with a wealth of information about children's strengths and help us to plan next steps in learning. Unfortunately, as a result of the school closure this year's programme has had to be postponed.

At present I do not have any further information about when testing will be arranged. Whilst we do value the information that we gain from the tests, especially in helping to identify learning loss, we will ensure that our priority for children is supporting their health and wellbeing upon their return to school.
