Covid -19 Update

I am pleased that case numbers in the local area are falling and hope that this is a continuing trend. We will continue to take all necessary measures to keep children and staff as safe as possible. I reviewed our building risk assessments this week with our health and safety officer and they have been fully updated for next term. Risk assessments will continue to be revised in light of any changes to Scottish Government restrictions e.g. indoor sports and physical activity.

A reminder that if you have to report a positive case of Covid-19, there are some different arrangements in place for the holiday period (2nd - 19th April). Last week I issued a letter which contains all of the information that you will need. A copy is posted on the school website.

Road Safety

The safety of children and families is our utmost priority and road safety is a key element of our Health and Wellbeing curriculum. Our former Principal Teacher Mrs Nisbet is currently working with an education company who are overhauling *Street Sense* learning and teaching resources. I am pleased that Crookfur will be able to pilot some of these new materials which I hope will be an engaging and informative way to deliver these very important safety messages across the school.

In the summer term, I am sure many of our children will be walking, scooting and cycling to school and so we will be sure to focus on developing road sense and road safety.

Mrs Slorach has arranged some Bikeability training for the upper school and information about this will be issued separately.

I know that all parents and carers are keen to ensure that the car park at Eastwood High School is as safe as possible. If you are using the car park, please ensure that you only park in a marked bay. No parking is permitted in the bus bay which runs alongside the sports centre. Parking here causes congestion and reduced visibility for pedestrians and drivers alike.
