A Day at Camp

For our camp activities, classes have been broken down into groups of 8.

Beyond this, attendees will also be separated by their school's bubble systems, meaning that children from separate bubbles will not mix.

What to Bring

For camp, we ask children to bring the following items:

- Swimsuit and towel
- A packed lunch
- Trainers they don't mind getting wet
- Clothes they do not mind getting muddy
- A dry change of clothes and shoes
- Sun cream and midge repellent
- A plastic bag for wet belongings to go home in



What to Leave at Home...

We ask that children please leave the following items at home:

- Mobile phones/technology
- Expensive/sentimental items (e.g. jewellery)
- Expensive outerwear and shoes



Safety & Security

Our camps operate on a ratio of 1:8. This means that all attendees are closely overseen by a trained member of the team.

And our team aren't just any staff, they are seasoned adventurers who are dedicated to their respective fields. While they may not need such advance qualifications for these camps, be reassured that our team are experts in their sports, and in the outdoors.

To maintain our high standards, we also hold an AALA license. This ensure that, as a provider, we adhere to strict safety management practices to keep both attendees and staff safe.



Our Covid-19 Policy

We have created a Covid-19 Policy to ensure all attendees at Non-Residential School Holiday Camps are being hosted in a safe and appropriate manner.

In line with this policy, we are maintaining the following duties to ensure that camp is safe for everyone...

- Sanitisation of all equipment between uses
- Sanitisation of toilets between each group, and reduced capacity within the toilet facilities
- Sanitisation of all transportation between uses, with social distancing in place on vehicles
- Staff testing twice a week
