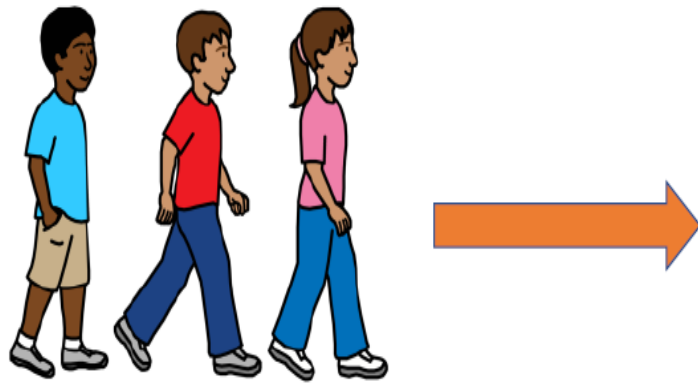


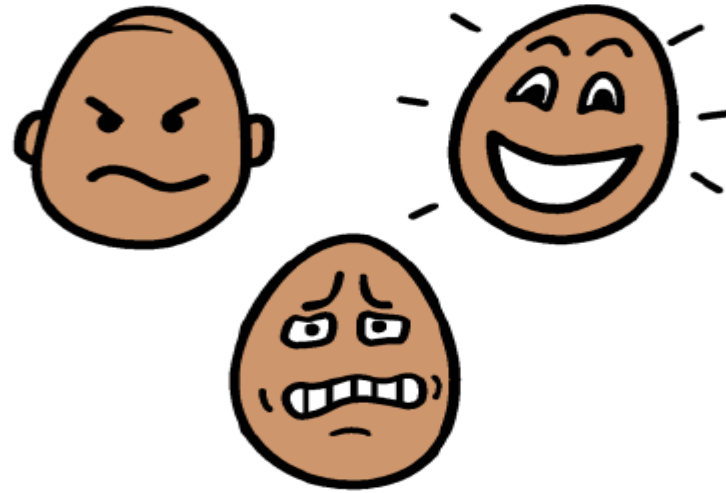
I am going back to

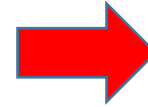
Mrs Jamieson is the Depute Head of Crookfur Primary and will be working closely with Primary 2 teachers and children.

I will have different PE times and Outdoor Learning times

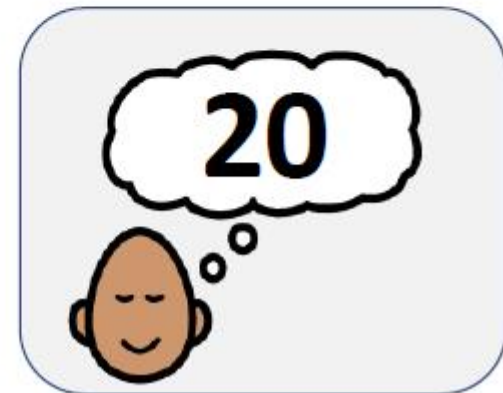
I will use different toilets.

will cough into my arm.



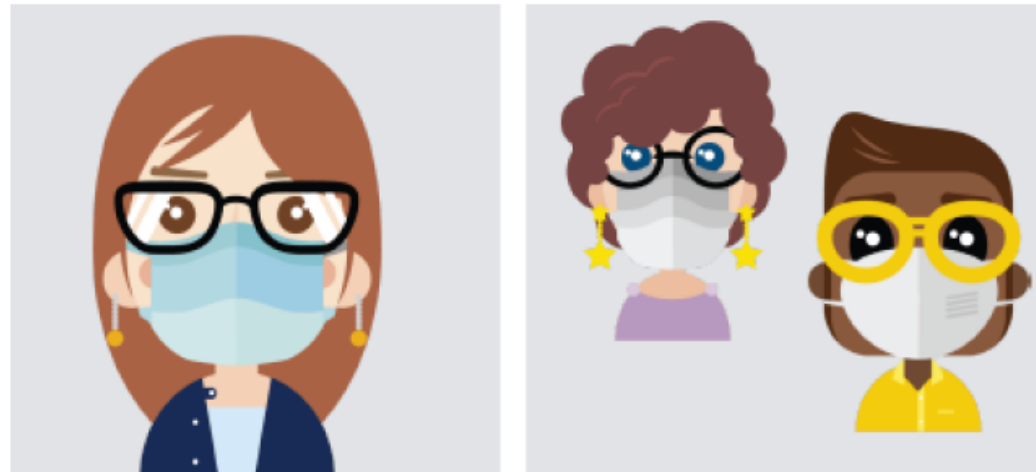
I will get tissues
when I need them.



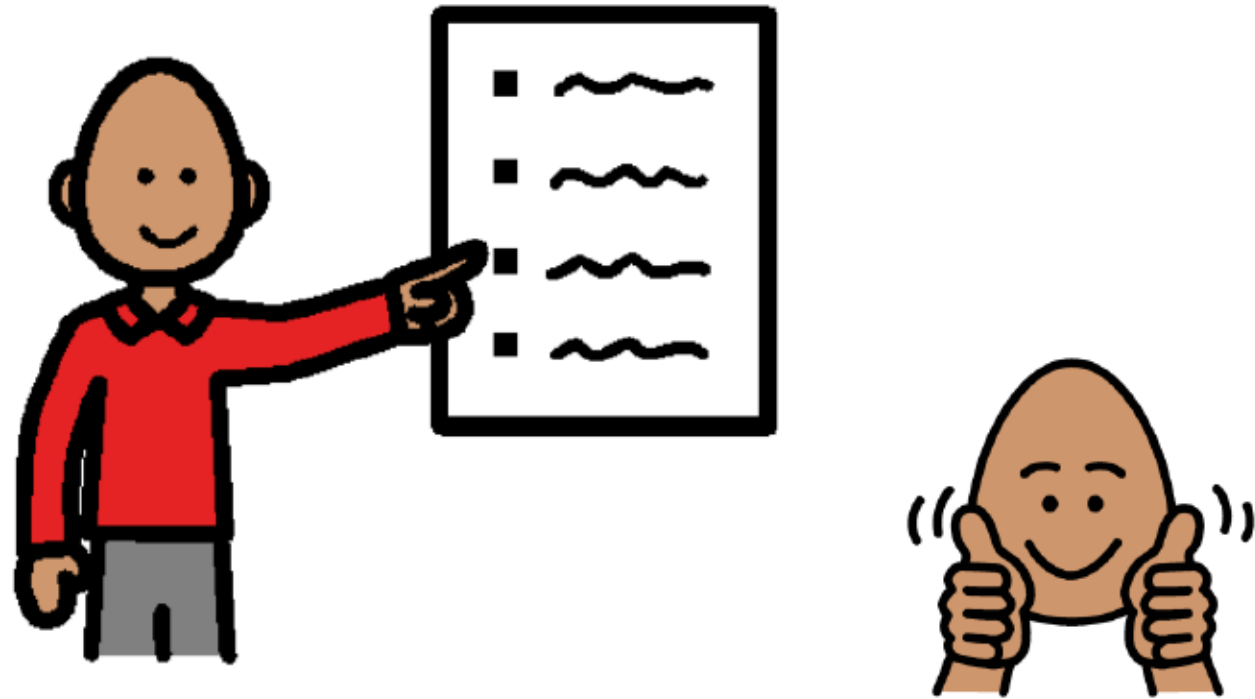
I will wash my hands

sneezing.



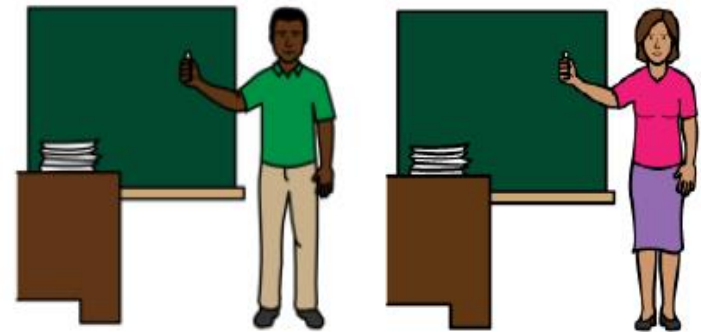
My teachers will wear masks. The masks cover their mouths and noses, but I can still see their eyes!
