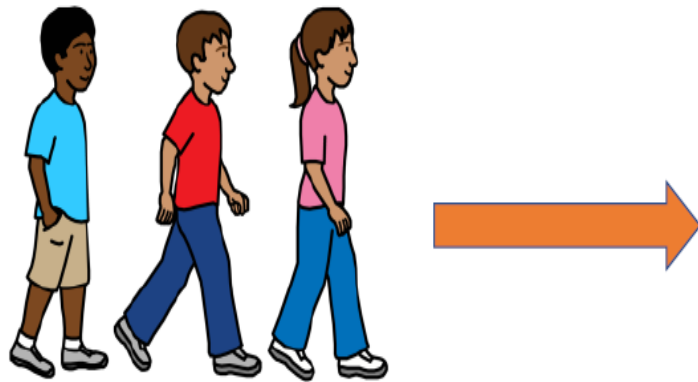


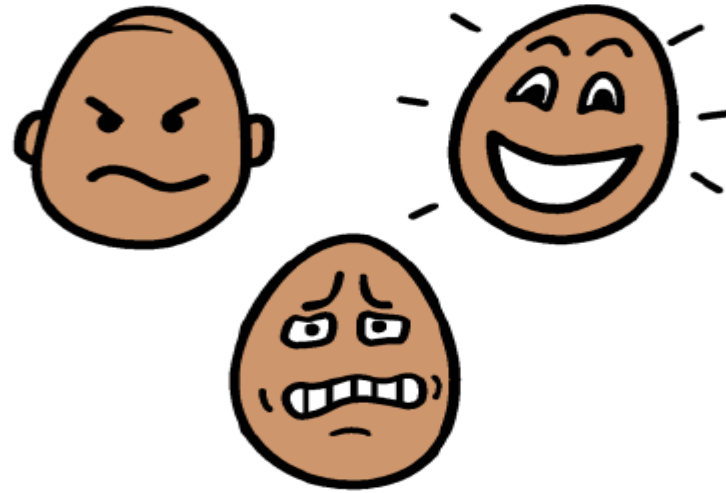
I am going back to

I will have different PE times and Outdoor learning times

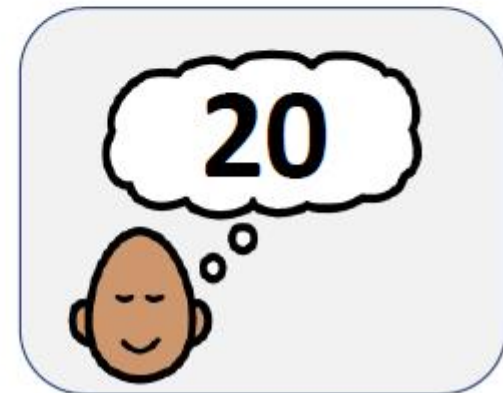
I will have a different teacher

will cough into my arm.



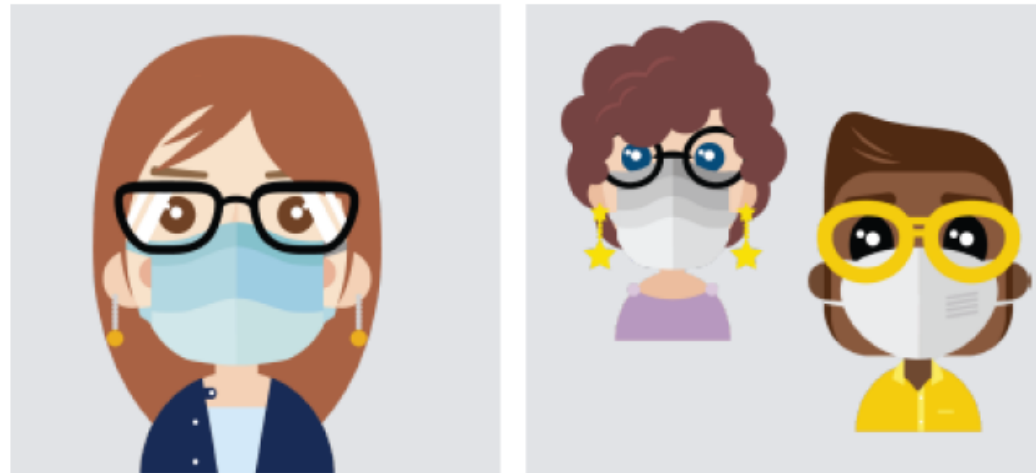
I will get tissues  
when I need them.



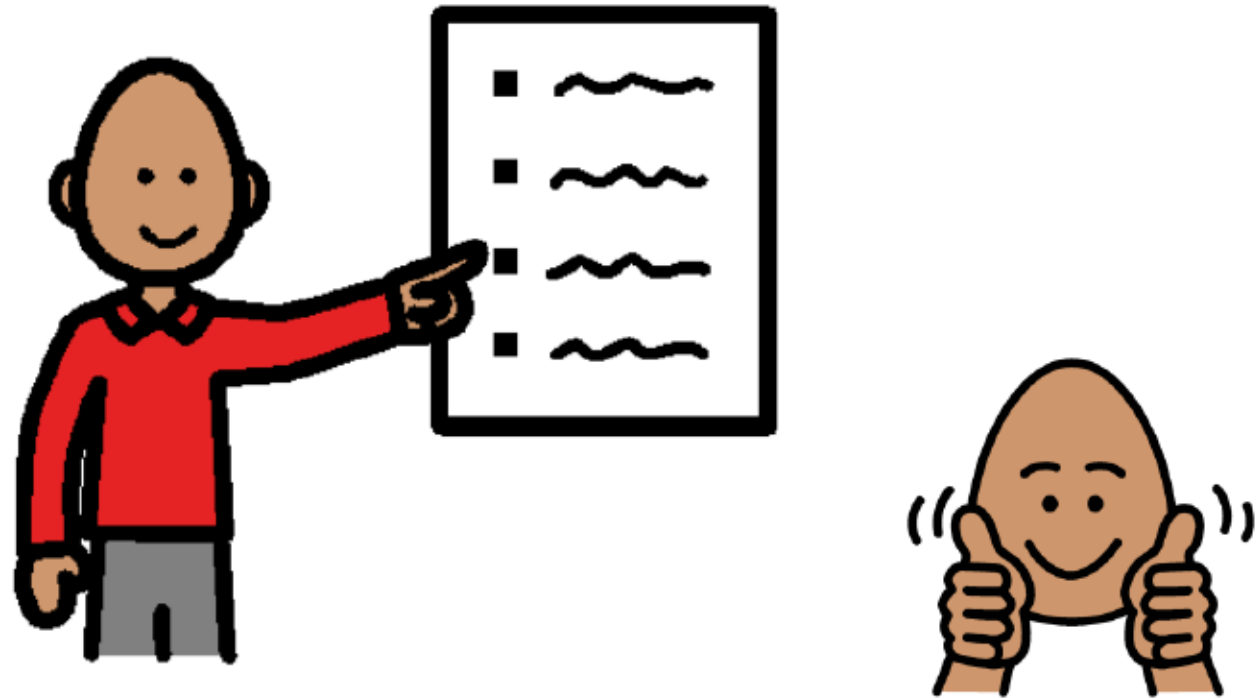
I will wash my hands

My teachers will wear masks. The masks cover their mouths and noses, but I can still see their eyes!

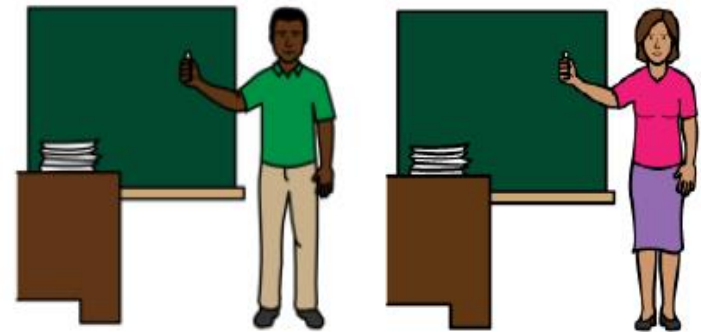


They wear the masks to keep everyone at school healthy and safe.



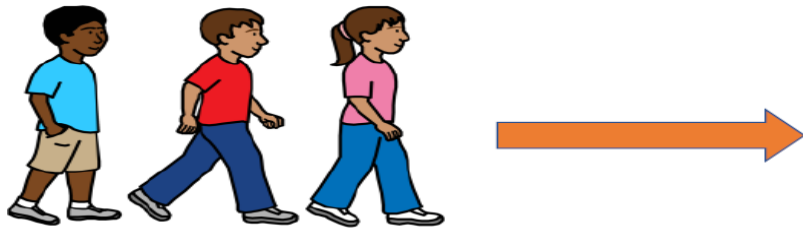
When I am at school I will follow the rules.
