#### Present Room

Thank you for all of the lovely donations for next week's Present Room event and my thanks to the P7 children who helpfully collected all of the donations from classes this morning. I've had a peak at the huge pile of gifts and I am sure you will be delighted to receive something from the collection on Christmas morning.

The Present Room will open on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> December and gifts will be priced £2.

A reminder that Friday 10<sup>th</sup> December is also Save the Children Christmas Jumper Day and we invite children and staff to join in by wearing their Christmas attire. Children are of course permitted to wear an alternative to a Christmas jumper e.g. Christmas t-shirt, antlers, Santa hat, tinsel etc. Where possible, school uniform should be worn as bottoms e.g. skirts, trousers, PE kit.

#### Christmas cards

Our Christmas post service is in operation this year and children can post Christmas cards to their friends in one of our dedicated post boxes. Cards will be delivered round classes by our post helpers and we ask that children remember to write their friends' full names and classes on the envelopes.

#### Timetables

To help with performance rehearsals, we have adjusted our PE timetable for the gym hall next week. Some sessions will now take place outdoors and so next week **children should wear outdoor PE kit on all of their PE days**. In the case of adverse weather, PE activities will be adapted and take place in class if necessary.

In addition, please note that next week, P3B and P4A have swapped a PE slot. P4A will have PE on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> and P3B on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup>. Teachers will post a reminder on their Google Classrooms.

## **Nut Free School**

I am sure that you will be aware that we continue to be a “Nut Free School”. Children must not bring any products containing nuts or those with nuts identified as allergens (usually in bold within the ingredient list), to school. During the festive season, children sometimes have different snacks or food items in their lunch boxes and I ask all parents to be especially vigilant at this time to any items which may contain nuts. Across the school, our Junior Road Safety officers have done a super job to highlight road safety messages this week. There have been lots of fun activities and quizzes to test children’s knowledge and raise awareness of road safety.

These are messages that we will continue to reinforce in school and our Junior Road Safety Officers will be working hard all year.

## **Diversity Group Update**

The Diversity Group met on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> December to plan actions for the New Year. Our Cost of the School Day Group will highlight the actions already taken in Crookfur to minimise additional costs, as well as survey parents to identify areas that could be worked on to further reduce costs.

Our race equality sub group will be looking at authentic festival celebrations as well as parent information about how we address incidences of racism in school.

Our LGBT inclusive practice group will support the school’s approaches to raising awareness and understanding of the diversity of family structures within our community and society as a whole. In addition to training for staff, we hope to arrange parent/carer information sessions. Further to this, we will continue to work to address unconscious gender bias and challenge gender stereotypes in the curriculum.

Our Diversity Group is informal and we enjoy lots of laughs as well as discussion on such a wide range of topics.
