Junior Road Safety Officers – Update

On Thursday last week, two of our Junior Road Safety Officers attended a Road Safety Event hosted by the Campus Police. There were speakers from all the services who keep us safe on the road including the Police Scotland, Scottish Fire & Rescue and the Scottish Ambulance Service. The JRSOs were given a tour of a police car and enjoyed a demonstration from the fire service. They also met the new mascot for East Renfrewshire Police, Jackton the Dog. We hope to arrange as many trips as possible this term, however, where we are unable to provide these, children can look forward to opportunities for excursions early next session.
