Planned Industrial Action

This afternoon we have issued a letter on behalf of the Director of Education which indicates that if strike action from the following Trade Unions - Unison, Unite and GMB is to go ahead, this will lead to school closure on Tuesday 6th, Wednesday 7th and Thursday 8th September.

We hope that a suitable pay agreement can be reached and this industrial action will be avoided.

Meet the Teacher – Wednesday 7th September 7pm-8pm

We hope to be able to host our Meet the Teacher evening as planned on Wednesday 7th September, however this may have to be cancelled as a result of the proposed industrial action.

If we are able to go ahead, this is an opportunity for parents/carers to visit their child(ren)'s class(es). You will be able to look around the environment and the teacher will provide an overview of how the class runs, including, rules and routines, homework, and class systems for rewards and celebration.

Each class visit will be approximately 15-20 minutes. The teacher will repeat their overview 3 times across the evening to enable parents/carers to visit multiple classes. Refreshments will be served in the hall.

This is a general introduction to the class and there will not be the opportunity to have individual discussions with the teacher about your child's progress. Individual parent-teacher meetings are scheduled for October.
