# Parent Council Update - Meeting 13/10/22

The second Parent Council meeting of the year was held last night and approval was given for additional funding towards the cost of class trips for each child. The Parent Council will offer a subsidy of £3 per child per year. This may be deducted from one trip or shared over a number of visits.

Mrs McGuigan and Mrs Jamieson spoke about the Playground Improvement Plan and the next stage is to meet with Pupil Leaders to get pupil input and involvement.
