Industrial Action

As indicated in the letter issued to parents and carers yesterday, planned strike action by the EIS and AHDS unions means that Crookfur Primary School will be closed to all children on **Thursday 24th November**. School will re-open as normal at 9am on Friday 25th November.

While the Council has been formally notified by trade unions of their intention to strike, there is also the possibility that through ongoing negotiations the strike may not take place. Book Week Scotland

All classes have enjoyed celebrating Book Week Scotland this week. Our assembly today gave each year group the opportunity to share their learning and explain how they have celebrated books and stories. Our whole school story sessions over the tannoy were a particular favourite and I would like to thank our fantastic P5 reading buddies for their confident and entertaining story times.

Anti-Bullying Week

Next week is Anti-Bullying Week. This year we are raising awareness using a whole school approach inspired by the community project *I am Me*.

The *I am Me* programme focuses on educating our children about different , sometimes hidden, difficulties and conditions with the aim of raising awareness and reducing bullying type behaviours and disability hate crimes.

All classes will explore these issues in an age appropriate way. Our current P7 classes completed a workshop last year as an introduction to this resource and to the message it gives. This year they are keen to roll this out across the school and with the help of their class teachers will visit P1-4 to deliver some lessons.

Primary 6 and Primary 7 will also benefit from a visit from our Campus Police Officer, PC Mitchell, who will speak with the children about online safety and cyberbullying.

Diversity Group Update

On Tuesday we had our second Diversity Group meeting of the year. We were joined by Marilyn Brennan (Quality Improvement Officer) to discuss how we feel social justice could be achieved and the steps we can take to tackle injustice. This generated a lot of rich discussion, which will help to inform a new East Renfrewshire Social Justice strategy.

We also discussed approaches to communication and how we promote parental involvement and engagement in school. This was supported by the results of our recent communication survey and I thank those parents and carers who took the time to complete the survey and share their views. We will seek ways to act on feedback and ensure that our approaches to communication are inclusive.

Scarlet Fever

There are recent reports that scarlet fever outbreaks are on the rise in some localities. Most cases (about 80%) of scarlet fever occur in children under 10.

Scarlet fever is very contagious, and it is important that people seek advice from their GP for a proper diagnosis and appropriate treatment. Initial symptoms usually include a sore throat, headache, and a high temperature (38.3C/101F or above), flushed cheeks and a swollen tongue.

If any children has a confirmed case of scarlet fever, they must not attend school for at least 24 hours after starting treatment with antibiotics.

Building Extension Update

I am sure you may be wondering, and probably assuming, that the extension to Crookfur Primary is not progressing as we had planned. Following approval of plans, the tender came back significantly above the original budget. Despite allocating additional capital to the project before going to tender, costs for the project were still well above expected levels.

As a consequence, the process has been paused for the moment and the council will look to go out to tender again early in 2023. We hope that the financial market may be more settled then and I will keep you up to date with any further progress.

Following our RSHP Education presentation on Tuesday, I remind you that we will host two drop in discussion sessions for parents and carers next week.

These will be held on Monday 21st November at 11am and Tuesday 22nd November at 2pm.
