Reinforce "Smart" rules with your children

SAFE - Staying safe online involves being careful and thinking about whether it is safe to give out personal information.



Reinforce "Smart" rules with your children

MEETING - Meeting up with someone you have contacted in cyberspace can be dangerous. If your children insist on meeting an online friend, ensure they have a responsible adult with them.



Reinforce "Smart" rules with your children

ATTACHMENTS - Accepting emails or opening files from people you don't know can be dangerous. They may contain viruses or nasty messages.



Reinforce "Smart" rules with your children

REMEMBER - Someone online maybe lying and not be who they say they are. If you feel uncomfortable when chatting or messaging, end the conversation.





Reinforce "Smart" rules with your children

TELL - Tell your parent/carer or teacher if someone or something makes you feel uncomfortable or worried.
