KitBags

During the in-service day staff received training on the use of 'KitBags'. This resource supports children in a range of ways in talking through difficult situations or expressing their emotions. Children and staff have found them very helpful as a way of enabling good communication.

Budget

The school budget remains in a healthy position, particularly due to the carry forwards from 17-18 and 18-19. New carpets in P4, 5 and 6 classes have made a huge difference to the quality of the learning environment. We have ordered 6 new Promethean boards, replacing those which were most out of date and a new speaker for the hall.

School fund is currently £1,030 which includes commission from Tempest in addition to the donation from the Parent Council. Examples of how these monies have been used is in supporting 'Families Connect', a parenting programme for P1 parents and the after school baking club.

Nursery Build

The nursery building works continue and are currently on track. Flemings were in P6 & P7 last week working with the children on maths, developing their understanding of scale. This children loved these lessons, in particular using the laser measuring tool.
