Points Noted From HT Discussion:

- P7s – hooded tops have been ordered from Audrey's. The PC have agreed that they will buy dictionaries – but this will be once the social distancing rules have been relaxed. The school are still working on a video and the Year Book. They also want to do something special for what would be the night of their Leavers Dance. Some members have volunteered to distribute items to the children if required. The PC thanked the teachers for going to so much effort. There will be transition days for P7s to prepare them for high school. Details will be sent next week to parents/carers. This will include a high school visit. The plan is for approximately 10 children from each class in school on a particular day. The children can bring in a shirt to be signed by their fellow classmates. NW will ask Nadia Sharif if she can supply cupcakes for the leavers as she usually makes a cake for this occasion.
- P1 Transition – 40+ children will be coming to Cross Arthurlie. A risk assessment is being carried out. No parents will be allowed in the school. There will be approximately 7 children in each class.
- FM, GR and Sharon Galloway have been working hard to organise the school set up for August.
- Other staff members will return to Cross Arthurlie next week as the hub school children will return to their own schools.
- School reports will be sent out by e-mail by the end of next week.
- The school are aware children will still have gym bags etc to be returned. This will be organised in an ordered and controlled way.
- Children will be placed in their school days based on their house – this is the easiest way to keep families in school on the same days. The maximum number per class is likely to be 13. The children are likely to be at school Monday and Tuesday or Thursday and Friday. There are plans for outdoor teaching.
- FM has a meeting with MACs.
- There was a discussion around nursery placing requests. The parents have been advised to contact the relevant head teacher with any queries.

- Sharon Galloway was successful in the principle teacher's post – along with Catriona Craig who is currently at Carlibar Primary School.
- Children due to come to Cross Arthurlie nursery will initially attend Carlibar or Arthurlie nursery.
