<p><u>Minutes from previous meeting – 7/12/21</u> Minutes approved</p> <p><u>Chairs Report</u> Everyone welcomed. It was very busy on the lead up to Christmas. Raised lots of money in difficult circumstances. Thank you to everyone involved. We have applied for funding through Barrhead Housing Association (BHA) - £1000 to be used to provide paediatric first aid. Proposal – Paediatric First aid classes for children and adults. Plan to run in school courses for 10% of pupils, and Subsidise 60 places for adults in the community – reducing cost to £15. Benefits everyone and builds life skills. 3 stages to a successful application.</p> <p>Community Grant Funding with Tesco is currently being applied for with the same proposal as BHA.</p> <p>ERC recruitment and selection training available for members to be available to be on an interview panel for the school if needed. Minimum of 3 members per committee. Lorna / Collette / Elaine currently trained. (leavers gift / contribute to activities / contribute to decorations and food) Last year - £600 was given – this year £850 will be available How much does band normally cost? £250/£275 Better when school kitchen provides the food. School will be fundraising for hoodies/trip. Suggested fundraising after trip but before Easter to allow purchase of hoodies.
